Using evidence-based peer-mediated approaches, the **TRACKS** program supports adult leaders to teach children the skills to be better friends to their peers with disabilities and social challenges. **TRACKS** creates an inclusive place where all KIDS have fun and belong!

The peer-mediated approach involves the adult approaching the peers to prompt the child with social challenges or disabilities to participate. **TRACKS** is named for the skills that are taught to peers in a child-friendly acronym. **TRACKS** has many benefits, some include: enhancing social interactions for ALL children, educating peers on how to interact with children with social challenge, and enhancing problem solving skills.
